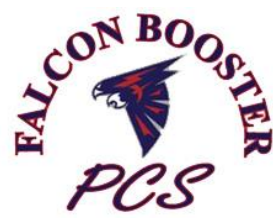

Adults \$5 per day

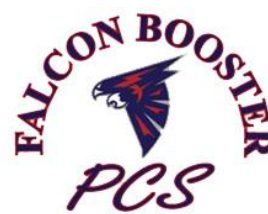
Students \$3 per day

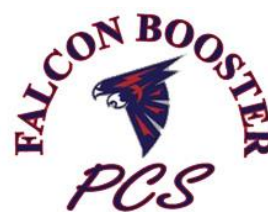

Rules for all Grades

1. Teams must check in 15 minutes before game time at the gym. Consent forms must be signed and turned in 30 minutes before the first game.
2. Regular basketball rules will be used with the exception of those listed below for this tournament.
3. A 28.5 size basketball will be used for all games. Game balls will be supplied for game play. Practice balls will not be supplied.
4. Players must play at their own grade level or at a grade level higher than their own grade level.
5. Only man to man defense is allowed during the game. This is determined by the officials. Not guarding your player or not playing your player at the level of the ball may be determined to be a zone, not help defense. A team will be warned once if they play zone and then a technical foul will be issued the second time.
6. Teams may press the last **one minute of the game**.
7. All teams must wear like uniforms with clearly visible numbers.
8. Park Christian School is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Teams should collect any valuables before the game. No locker rooms are available. A bathroom will be available.

Game Related Information

1. Halves will be 16 minutes with running time. Time will stop for time outs or injuries. Time outs are 30 seconds long. Stop time will be used the last one minute of the game.
2. Two time outs per half with no carryover; one extra time out for overtime.
3. Players must drop back to half court after a missed shot. Pressing is allowed the last minute of the game.
4. If the game is tied at the end of regulation, there will be a one minute overtime. If the game is tied after the first overtime, the second overtime will be sudden death (first team to score wins).
5. There will be a 4 minute half time.
6. Forfeits count as a game.
7. Warm up time allowed before a game will be at the discretion of the officials or tournament manager.
8. Games may begin earlier than scheduled – please arrive early to plan accordingly.
