

Concession Stand General Information:

Set-Up

Most ingredients, candy, and supplies are located in the metal cabinet by the hot dog warmer. Popcorn supplies and cleaning supplies for shake machine are located under the popcorn popper. Extra supplies are located in boxes on top of the cupboards. (cups, spoons, forks, chips, etc.)

Pop is located in the pop cooler.

The bottom shelf of the refrigerator is for concession stand use. Please get and put all refrigerated items on the bottom shelf of the refrigerator.

Popcorn Popper

Plug in the popcorn machine.

Turn on the power and the kettle.

Place 1/3 cup oil in the kettle.

When oil smells hot, add 1 cup popcorn with 1 ½ tsp popcorn salt poured on top.

Put cover down over kettle and let it pop.

When popping slows way down, dump popcorn out of kettle. Please don't swing kettle back and forth. Use the scoop or a fork to clean out kettle.

Turn off kettle.

Fill bags ¾ full with popcorn

Start over again until you get desired amount of popcorn. (start with 3-4 kettles)

Each kettle makes about 4-6 bags of popcorn.

If making caramel corn, follow directions on caramel bag.

Hot Dog Machine

Put on gloves

Place hot dogs on rollers to warm.

It takes about 20 - 30 minutes to warm the hot dogs.

Start on high and turn down as hot dogs get warm.

Start with 8-10 hot dogs

Place hot dog on bun and serve in hot dog trays or in green paper.

Put out ketchup and mustard on table for guests to use for their hot dogs.

Pop Cooler

Place one type of each pop on counter so guests can see the options.

Candy

Place tubs of candy out on the serving cart for guests to see.

Place items of same price together. (75 cents for normal candy bars and bags, 25 cents for suckers, airheads, etc.)

Walking Tacos

Place a crock pot liner in the crock pot. (Crock pot is located in bottom middle wood cupboard.)
Place meat in the liner
Heat meat in the crock pot and keep on low. (this may take up to an hour to heat) You may want to microwave some first. Then put in the crock pot to keep warm.
Put on gloves
Open bag of Doritos or chips. (Crush chips a bit and cut along the long side.)
Place two scoops of meat in the bag.
To store cheese and lettuce, fill large bowl with ice and place plastic bags of lettuce and cheese on top.
Top each taco with a handful of lettuce
Top each taco with a handful of cheese
Serve with a fork.

Put out sour cream and salsa on a table for guests to use. Place sour cream in a bowl of ice to keep it chilled.

Shake Machine

Wash hands.
Put the inside of the machine together following directions in manual. (located under popcorn machine)
Plug in machine.
Take 2 gallon bucket under popcorn machine.
Put 2 ounces (1 small plastic cup $\frac{3}{4}$ full) of sanitizer into bucket and fill with warm water.
Pour water into the top of the shake machine
Use brush to clean top and small hole.
Turn to wash.
Let wash for 5 minutes.
Drain out the water from the front of the machine.
Add 2 white and 2 chocolate cartons of shake mix. (pour 1 white and 1 chocolate in at the same time to mix them together.)
Turn machine to auto.
When machine cycles off, the shakes are ready to serve.
Fill white cups about $\frac{3}{4}$ full.
Throw the first shake away since it may have some cleaning residue on it.
Serve with a spoon.

When red light comes on, there is enough shake mix to make about 20 more shakes.
Add 1 white and 1 chocolate at a time to ensure coolness of the mix. Do not add any shake product after the varsity half time or after the 1st game of varsity volleyball. .
When game is almost over, start selling product at a reduced rate to empty the machine out.
